

Frequently Asked TORO Registration Questions

Do I receive a discount if I sign-up online? YES! Online memberships are \$20; if you wait and sign-up at the race, the fee is \$50. That is a \$30 per membership savings!!

Do I need to have my race letter/number on my bike? YES! The TORO riding number must be displayed on front and side number plates to receive points. Letters and numbers on number plates must be a minimum of 3" tall and in a color of high contrast to the background.

Do you have numbers available? TORO has partnered with Powersport Grafx to provide low-cost, custom decals for our members! When you sign up online you will be given the following options to take advantage of through October 15, 2008:

Optional Number Sets	
Option 1	Order a standard package. These graphics are 4 mil. ovals, black on white. A set for your bike (all three plates) is \$5.00. Once your number is assigned, the graphics will be ordered and you may pick them up at the TORO trailer at your first race. This offer is good for registrations completed and payment received through October 15th, 2008. View a sample.
Option 2	Place a custom graphic order directly with Powersport Grafx once you have received e-mail verification of your TORO riding number. Contact Matthew at 800-903-6764. If Matthew is unavailable, anyone in sales will be able to assist you. Orders placed by 11:00 a.m. ET will ship the next day. You can order black on white at \$29.95 or two-color at \$39.95. Both sets are 14 mil. ovals with the rider name included. View samples.
Option 3	Custom number plate background orders may be placed with Powersport Grafx at a 20% off discount once you have received e-mail verification of your TORO riding number. Simply call the number above or visit their web site at www.ridepg.com .

Do you sell numbers at the races? Yes and No. Number sets will be provided to the people who wait and sign-up at the race for a \$10 charge (you will be assigned a number we have in stock). There will be no individual numbers available for sale.

Is my number mine when I sign up online or when you receive payment? When we receive payment, you will get a confirmation of your racing number.

How does the "earned number" thing work? If you place in the Top 10 of your class last season, you may run that earned number this season ONLY IF you remain in that same class. By example: If you placed 8th in the +30C class, you may run the C408 number that is reserved just for you OR you may pick another number in that class that will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

How do I move down from A to B or from the B class to a C class? To request a move to a lower level class, send a written request to jeff.vm@verizon.net or mail it to the attention of Jeff Van Matre (Scoring Director) at 2125 Larkspur Drive,

Carrollton, Texas 75010. This must be done at least one week prior to the race weekend so proper research of lap times can be completed by the committee.

Does the transponder I have for STORM, TCCRA or TORN work for TORO or do I need to purchase another? You can use the same transponder for all four series. Please make sure you have it programmed with your number for that series BEFORE you race so you will be scored properly.

Will I be able to pay for my online registration with a credit card? Yes.

If I prefer to mail in a check with my online registration, where do I send it? Checks payable to: TORO, 2125 Larkspur Drive, Carrollton, Texas 75010

Will you be checking IDs and Birth Certificates for Age, Mini and Pee Wee classes? YES at your first race please have your proof of age.

How will I know if you got my check and what my number is for sure? You will see yourself listed under the "Administration" tab of the TORO website "Rider Directory" and if you gave us your e-mail address, you will receive a confirmation e-mail.
