Crouch Takes the Last Round Win!

The final round of the Tucker Rocky/MSR/Answer/ProTaper-sponsored Texas Off-road Racing Organization took place in Gordon, Texas and was promoted by the TORO staff. Race Chairman, Kevin Breton did a nice job of putting together a very fun, challenging course that utilized all of the surrounding rock-filled hills and sweeping woods.

In Saturday's Pee Wee action, it was Ty Collins taking the win in the 65 B class and Alex Isakson the win in the 65C class, but Justin Bailey and Trenton Thompson were the season victors in the two classes. 65 A rider Ryan McKinney made a clean sweep of his class and took the overall Pee Wee title. 50 A rider Cole Neal, 50 B rider Colton Hansen and 50 C rider Allen Narita all took the win and clenched the season victory in their respective classes.

In Sunday's AA race, it was last year's AA champion Yamaha/Maxxis/IMS rider Matt Crouch putting it all together to take the win; his first of the season. Crouch said, "Beau Otto and I got a really good jump on the start and went one-two into the first woods section. We started pulling away from the rest of the field very quickly."

SMS Racing/Silkolene/MSR-sponsored Otto said, "I took the holeshot and held the lead as long as I could, but the track was rocky and demanding and I could feel myself getting arm pump. That's when Crouch got by me for the lead. I stayed a distant second for a while with Cameron Ishmael right on my tail, when all of the sudden my arm pump just went away and I was on the charge again."

Crouch said, "I made a really big mistake on a rock section and decided to dial it back a bit to hold on to the lead. I rode the last lap pretty conservatively. I gave up a lot of time and nearing the end of the lap, Otto caught up to me with only about two miles to the checkered. I was able to pick up the pace again and get the win."

Sixteen-year-old Family Powersports of McKinney/Precision Motorcycle Products/Tucker Rocky-sponsored Cooper Bailey came in sixth, but with his sizeable lead in series points it was enough for the AA TORO Championship with Otto in second and SMS Racing/MSR/Silkolene-sponsored Brian Storrie rounding out the top three.

In other long course action, Heavy A rider David Lucas, Jr., Lite A rider Garrett Bollom, +30 B rider Stephen Nowak and +40 B rider Terry Poe all took the win and series championships in their respective classes.

During the one-hour-plus-a-lap program it was +50 A rider Jeff Kring, +45 B rider Brad Burnie, +30 C JD Seale, +40 C rider Terry Harmon, +60 rider Dwight Leatherwood, +45 C rider Quentin Bohrer and +50 C rider Bruce Anderson who all captured the win and with it, the series championship in their classes.

The Maxim Motorsport-sponsored Overall A custom helmet went to Over 30 A rider Cecil Parker. Parker put together a perfect season to take the top A rider honors.
